

- For Parallel use a bi-directional shield interface cable that is IEEE 1284-compliant, and not longer than 6 feet (2 meters).
- For USB use a Hi-Speed USB 2.0 interface cable that is not longer than 6 feet (2 meters).
- Please make sure that you use a Hi-Speed USB 2.0 certified cable if your computer uses a Hi-Speed USB 2.0 interface.
- Even if your computer has a USB 1.1 interface, you can connect the DCP.


