

Unpack the machine and check the components



WARNING

Plastic bags are used in the packaging of your machine. To avoid danger of suffocation, please keep these bags away from babies and children.



- The components included in the box may differ depending on your country.
- Save all packing materials and the box in case for any reason you must ship your machine.
- The interface cable is not a standard accessory. Buy the appropriate interface cable for the interface you
 want to use (USB).

USB cable


- Please make sure you use a USB 2.0 cable (Type A/B) that is no longer than 2 metres.
- DO NOT connect the interface cable at this time. Connecting the interface cable is done during MFL-Pro installation process.
- When you use a USB cable, make sure you connect it to the USB port of your computer and not to a USB port on a keyboard or non-powered USB hub.




Install the drum unit and toner cartridge assembly


O IMPORTANT

DO NOT connect the interface cable yet.




- Remove the protective tape and film covering the scanner glass.
- Press the front cover release button and open the front cover 1.






 Unpack the drum unit and toner cartridge assembly.




Gently shake it from side to side several times to distribute the toner evenly inside the assembly.



Put the drum unit assembly into the machine until it clicks into place.




Close the front cover of the machine.




Load paper in the paper tray


Pull the paper tray completely out of the machine.



While pressing the blue paper-guide release lever 1, slide the paper guides to fit the paper size you are loading in the tray. Make sure that the guides are firmly in the slots.




Fan the stack of paper well to avoid paper jams and misfeeds.



Put paper in the tray, and make sure that the paper is below the maximum paper mark 1.

The side to be printed on must be face down.




O IMPORTANT

Make sure the paper guides touch the sides of the paper so it will feed correctly.

- Put the paper tray firmly back in the machine.

 Make sure that it is completely inserted into the machine.
- Unfold the support flap 1 to prevent paper from sliding off the face-down output tray.






Connect the power cord


O IMPORTANT

DO NOT connect the interface cable yet.

Make sure that the machine power switch is off. Connect the AC power cord to the machine.



Plug the AC power cord into an AC outlet. Turn the power switch on.

Choose your language

After turning the power switch on, the LCD shows:

Select Language Press OK Key

Press **OK**.

Press or to choose your language and press **OK**.

Select ▲▼ or OK English

The LCD prompts you to confirm your selection.

English? 1.Yes 2.No

If the LCD shows the correct language, press ${\bf 1}$.

-OR-

Press 2 to go back to step a to choose the language again.



If you have set the wrong language, you can change the language from the control panel menu of the machine. (Menu, 1, 0)

Set the LCD contrast (if needed)

If you are having difficulty reading the LCD, try changing the contrast setting.

- Press Menu.
- Press 1.
- C Press 5.
- d Press to increase the contrast.

-OR-

Press to decrease the contrast.

Press OK.

Press Stop/Exit.



Set the date and time

This setting allows the machine to name files created when using the Scan to USB feature.

- Press Menu.
- Press 5.
- C Press 1.
- Enter the last two digits of the year on the dial pad, and then press **OK**.

Date&Time Year:2009

(e.g. Enter 0, 9 for 2009.)

Enter the two digits for the month on the dial pad, and then press **OK**.

Date&Time Month:03

(e.g. Enter 0, 3 for March.)

Enter the two digits for the day on the dial pad, and then press **OK**.

Date&Time Day:25

(e.g. Enter 2, 5.)

Enter the time in 24-hour format on the dial pad, and then press **OK**.

Date&Time Time:15:25

(e.g. Enter 15, 25 for 3:25 P.M.)

Press Stop/Exit.

Automatic Daylight Savings Time

You can set the machine to change automatically for daylight savings time. It will reset itself forward one hour in the Spring and backward one hour in the Autumn.

- Press Menu.
- Press 5.
- C Press 2.
- Press or to choose on (or off).

 Press ok.
- Press Stop/Exit.



Before you install

Make sure that your computer is ON and you are logged on with Administrator rights.

• IMPORTANT

- DO NOT connect the USB cable yet.
- If there are any programs running, close them.
- Make sure a USB Flash memory drive is not inserted into the machine.
- The screen may differ depending on the operating system.
- The supplied CD-ROM includes ScanSoft™ PaperPort™ 11SE. This software supports Windows® 2000 (SP4 or greater), XP (SP2 or greater), XP Professional x64 Edition and Windows Vista®. Update to the latest Windows® Service Pack before installing MFL-Pro Suite.
- Turn off and unplug the machine from the AC outlet and disconnect it from your computer, if you already connected an interface cable.

Install MFL-Pro Suite

Put the supplied CD-ROM into your CD-ROM drive. If the model name screen appears, choose your machine. If the language screen appears, choose your language.





If the Brother screen does not appear automatically, go to **My Computer (Computer)**, double-click the CD-ROM icon, and then double-click **Start.exe**.

The CD-ROM top menu will appear. Click Initial Installation.




Click Install MFL-Pro Suite.







Connect the power cord

Finish and restart

If an error message appears during the software installation, run the Installation Diagnostics located in Start/All Programs/Brother /DCP-XXXX (where DCP-XXXX is your model name).

In the Check for Firmware Updates screen, choose the firmware update setting you want and click OK. If you disabled the Status Monitor setting in step h the screen will not appear.





Internet access is required for the firmware upgrade.


To use the machine safely

Please keep these instructions for later reference and read them before attempting any maintenance.

WARNING



There are high voltage electrodes inside the machine. Before you clean the inside of the machine, make sure you have unplugged the power cord from the electrical socket. Doing this will prevent an electrical shock.





DO NOT handle the plug with wet hands. Doing this might cause an electrical shock. Always make sure the plug is fully inserted.



This product must be installed near an electrical socket that is easily accessible. In case of an emergency, you must unplug the power cord from the electrical socket to shut off the power completely.




