

Packing List


Make sure you have the items shown below.




- * The printing cartridge is already installed in the machine.

- **B.** Attach the paper tray.






Load the Paper


A. Place up to 30 sheets of paper in the paper






Connect the handset, power cord and telephone line cord

Set Date and Time

- A. Press Menu/Set, 1, 2
- B. Enter the last two digits of the year, and then press Menu/Set.
- C. Enter two digits for the month, and then press Menu/Set.
- **D.** Enter two digits for the day, and then press
- E. Enter the time in 24-hour format, and then press Menu/Set.
- F. Press Stop.

Set Station ID

A. Press Menu/Set, 1, 3

then press Menu/Set.

- **D.** Enter your name (up to 20 characters) using the dial pad and the chart, and then press Menu/Set.

Select Receive Mode

Choose the mode that best suits your needs by pressing Mode repeatedly until the screen displays the setting you want to use.

FAX ONLY For use with a dedicated fax line. Every call is answered as a

FAX/TEL TAD: ANSWER MACH.

For receiving fax and voice calls on one line.

(FAX-T84 only) For use with an external answering device. The TAD answers every call and stores voice messages.

Fax messages are printed. MANUAL For receiving fax and voice calls on one line. You control the

phone line and must answer every call yourself.

Once an Outgoing message has been recorded, you can choose the mode below by pressing (i) until it lights. (FAX-T86 only)

TAD: MSG MGR A built-in answering machine answers every call and stores voice and fax messages. For details, see chapter 11 of the Owner's Manual.

Sending Faxes

Automatic Transmission

- Insert the document face down in the ADF.
- **2** Enter the fax number using the dial pad, One Touch, Speed Dial or Search.
- 3 Press Start.

Manual Transmission

Manual transmission lets you hear the dial tone, ringing and fax receiving tones before sending the fax.

- 1 Insert the document face down in the ADF.
- Pick up the handset and listen for a dial tone.—OR—
 - Press **Speaker Phone** (FAX-T86).
- 3 Enter the fax number using the dial pad, One Touch, Speed Dial or Search.
- **4** When you hear the fax tone, press **Start**. If you are using the handset, hang up.

Receiving Faxes

For a detailed explanation about receiving faxes please see Chapter 3 and 8 of the Owner's Manual.

Manual Reception

- 1 Pick up the handset.
- **2** Press **Start** if you hear fax tones (beeps).
- **Note:** If you set Fax Detect to ON, you don't have to press **Start**. Just wait until the machine takes over the call automatically. (See *Fax Detect* in the Owner's Manual.)
- **3** When the LCD shows **RECEIVE**, replace the handset.

Making Copies

Making a Single Copy

- 1 Insert the document face down in the ADF.
- **2** Press Copy/Help twice.

To cancel, press **Stop**.

Do NOT pull on the paper while copying is in progress.

Setup Auto Dial Numbers

Storing One-Touch Dial Numbers

- **1** Press **Menu/Set**, **6**, **1**.
- **2** Press the One Touch key where you want to store the number.
- **3** Enter a number (up to 20 digits), and then press **Menu/Set**.
- **4** Enter a name (up to 15 characters), and then press **Menu/Set**.
- 5 Press or ► to select FAX, TEL or F/T (according to the type of number you stored), and then press Menu/Set.
- 6 Press Stop.

Storing Speed Dial Numbers

- 1 Press Menu/Set, 6, 2.
- **2** Enter a two-digit speed dial number, and then press **Menu/Set**.
- **3** Enter a number (up to 20 digits), and then press **Menu/Set**.
- 4 Enter a name (up to 15 characters), and then press **Menu/Set**.
- 5 Press or ► to select FAX, TEL or F/T (according to the type of number you stored), and then press Menu/Set.
- 6 Press Stop.

Dialling Options

One-Touch Dialling

- Pick up the handset.

 Press the One Touch key of the location you want to call.
- **2** To hang up, replace the handset.

Speed Dialling

- Pick up the handset.
 - Press **Mute/Search**, press **#**, and then press the two-digit Speed Dial number.
- **2** To hang up, replace the handset.

Searching the Auto Dial Numbers

- 1 Press Mute/Search, and then enter the first letter of the name you are looking for.
- **2** Press \triangleleft or \triangleright to search the memory.
- **3** When the name is displayed, lift the handset for a voice call.
 - —OR—

Press Speaker phone (FAX-T86).

4 Press **Start** to begin dialling.

Message Manager (FAX-T86 Only)

Turning ON Message Manager Mode

For a more detailed explanation please see Chapter 11 of the Owner's Manual.

- Record the Outgoing Message (TAD MESSAGE).
- **2** Press (a) until it lights.

Recording OGM

- 1 Press Menu/Set, 8, 3.
- 3 Press or ► to select RECORD MSG, and then press Menu/Set.
- 4 Pick up the handset to record a message.
- **5** Replace the handset.

Playing a Voice Message

- 1 Press Play/Record.
- 2 Use * (RWD) to repeat a message. Use # (FWD) to skip a message.
- **3** Press **Stop**.

Printing a Fax Message

- 1 Press Play/Record.
- **2** After voice messages have played, press **1**.

Erasing Messages

To erase voice messages individually

- 1 Press Play/Record.
- **2** Press **Erase** after the two short beeps or while the message is playing.
- **3** Press **1**.
- 4 Press Stop.

To erase messages all at once

- 1 Press Erase.
- Press or ➤ to select VOICE, DOC or MSG., and then press Menu/Set.
- **3** Press **1**.
