


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
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Carton components



An interface cable is not a standard accessory. You need to purchase an appropriate USB 2.0 interface cable or network cable.

USB cable


- Please make sure you use a USB 2.0 cable that is no longer than 2 metres (6 feet) long.
- Your MFC has a USB interface that is compatible with the USB 2.0 specification.
- DO NOT connect the interface cable at this time. Connecting the interface cable is done during the software installation process.

Network cable

Use a straight-through Category5 (or greater) twisted-pair cable for 10BASE-T or 100BASE-TX Fast Ethernet Network.



Removing the protective parts

- Remove the protective tape and film covering the scanner glass.
- 2 Remove the foam bag containing the ink cartridges from on top of the paper tray.








3 Loading paper



- You can load up to 100 sheets of 80 g/m² (20 lb) paper. For details, see Acceptable paper and other media in Chapter 2 of the User's Guide.
- Pull the paper tray completely out of the machine and lift the output paper tray cover (1).





Press and slide the paper side guides (1) and paper length guide (2) to fit the paper size.




Fan the stack of paper well to avoid paper jams and misfeeds.



 Gently put the paper into the paper tray print side down and top edge first.
 Check that the paper is flat in the tray.




Gently adjust the paper side guides with both hands to fit the paper. Make sure that the paper guides touch the edges of the paper.


Be careful that you do not push the paper in too far; it may lift at the back of the tray and cause paper feed problems. 6 Close the output paper tray cover.





Slowly push the paper tray completely into the machine.



While holding the paper tray in place, pull out the paper support (①) until it clicks, and then unfold the paper support flap (②).



🖉 Note

Do not use the paper support flap for Legal paper.




You can use the photo paper tray which is located on the top of the paper tray to print on photo 10 x 15 cm (4 x 6 in.) and photo L size paper. For details, see Loading envelopes, post cards and photo paper in Chapter 2 of the User's Guide.

Connecting the phone line

Connect the telephone line cord. Connect one end of the telephone line cord to the socket on the machine marked **LINE** and the other end to a modular wall socket.







Connecting the power cord

Connect the power cord.



Warning

- The machine must be fitted with an earthed plug.
- Since the machine is grounded through the power outlet, you can protect yourself from potentially hazardous electrical conditions on the telephone network by keeping the power cord connected to your machine when you connect it to a telephone line. Similarly, you can protect yourself when you want to move your machine by disconnecting the telephone line first and then the power cord.

6 Installing the ink cartridges

Warning

If ink gets in your eyes, wash them out with water at once, and if irritation occurs consult a doctor.

1 Make sure that the power is turned on. The LCD shows:






Open the ink cartridge cover (1).



3 Pull all the lock release levers down and remove the yellow protective part (1).






Note

Do not throw away the yellow protective part. You will need it if you transport the machine.



Take out the ink cartridge.






Carefully remove the protective yellow cap (1).



If the protective yellow cap comes off when you open the bag, the cartridge will not be damaged.


TEP1 Setting Up the Machine

6 Install each ink cartridge in the direction of the arrow on the label.

Take care to match the colour of the lock release lever (1) with the cartridge colour (2), as shown in the diagram below.




7 Lift each lock release lever and gently push it until it clicks, and then close the ink cartridge cover.



🖉 Note

If the LCD prompts you to re-insert the ink cartridge correctly, after you install the ink cartridges, check that the ink cartridges are installed correctly. The machine will clean the ink tube system for use for the first time. This process will occur only once, the first time ink cartridges are installed. The cleaning process will last approximately four minutes. The LCD shows:



Caution

- DO NOT take out ink cartridges if you do not need to replace them. If you do so, it may reduce the ink quantity and the machine will not know the quantity of ink left in the cartridge.
- DO NOT shake the ink cartridges. If ink stains your skin or clothing, wash with soap or detergent at once.
- DO NOT repeatedly insert and remove the cartridges. If you do so, ink may seep out of the cartridge.
- If you mix the colours by installing an ink cartridge in the wrong position, clean the print head several times after correcting the cartridge installation. (See *Cleaning the print head in Appendix B of the User's Guide.*)
- Once you open an ink cartridge, install it in the machine and use it up within six months of installation. Use unopened ink cartridges by the expiration date written on the cartridge package.
- DO NOT dismantle or tamper with the ink cartridge, this can cause the ink to leak out of the cartridge.
- Brother multifunction machines are designed to work with ink of a particular specification and will work to a level of optimum performance when used with genuine Brother branded ink cartridges. Brother cannot guarantee this optimum performance if ink or ink cartridges of other specifications are used. Brother does not therefore recommend the use of cartridges other than genuine Brother branded cartridges with this machine or the refilling of empty cartridges with ink from other sources. If damage is caused to the print head or other parts of this machine as a result of using incompatible products with this machine, any repairs required as a result may not be covered by the warranty.

Setting Up the Machine



After the cleaning cycle is finished, the LCD shows:






Make sure paper is loaded in the paper tray. Press Colour Start.

The machine starts printing the Print Quality Check Sheet (only during initial ink cartridge installation).

Check the quality of the four colour blocks on the sheet.

(black/yellow/cyan/magenta)

Avoid touching the printed surface of the paper immediately after printing, the surface may not be completely dry and may stain your fingers.

- If all lines are clear and visible, press 1 (Yes) on the dial pad to finish the quality check.
- If you can see missing short lines, press 2 (No) on the dial pad and go to step 6.

- 7 Press 1 (Yes), the machine will then start cleaning the colours.
 - After cleaning is finished, press **Colour Start**. The machine starts printing the Print Quality Check Sheet again and goes back to step **3**.

8 Setting the LCD contrast

You can adjust the LCD contrast for a sharper and more vivid display. If you are having difficulty reading the LCD, try changing the contrast setting.

- 1 Press Menu.
- Press ▲ or ▼ to choose General Setup. Press OK.
- Or V to choose LCD Settings. Press OK.
- Press ▲ or ▼ to choose LCD Contrast. Press OK.
- 5 Press ▲ or ▼ to choose Light, Med or Dark. Press OK.
- 6 Press Stop/Exit.

Note

You can also adjust the angle of the LCD display by lifting it.

9 Setting the date and time

The machine displays the date and time, and if you set up the station ID it will add it to each fax you send.

- 1 Press Menu.
- Press ▲ or ▼ to choose Initial Setup. Press OK.
- 3 Press ▲ or ▼ to choose Date/Time. Press OK.
- 4
 - Enter the last two digits of the year on the dial pad, and then press **OK**.



7 Enter the time in 24-hour format on the dial pad, and then press **OK**.



(e.g. Enter 1 5, 2 5 for 3:25 P.M.)

- Press Stop/Exit.
- To confirm the current date and time, print out the Users Settings Report. (See Printing Reports in Chapter 11 of the User's Guide.)


10 Setting your station ID

You should store your name and fax number to be printed on all fax pages that you send.

- Press Menu.
- Press ▲ or ▼ to choose Initial Setup. Press OK.
- 3 Press ▲ or ▼ to choose Station ID. Press OK.
- Enter your fax number (up to 20 digits) on the dial pad, and then press OK. To enter a "+" for international codes, press X. For example, to enter the UK dialling code "+44", press X, 4, 4 and then the rest of your number.



5 Enter your name (up to 20 characters) using the dial pad, and then press **OK**.



🖉 Note

- See the following chart for entering your name.
- If you need to enter a character that is on the same key as the last character, press is to move the cursor to the right.
- If you entered a letter incorrectly and want to change it, press e or b to move the cursor under the incorrect character, press Clear/Back.

11 Setting tone or pulse dialling mode

Your machine comes set for a Tone dialling service. If you have a Pulse dialling service (rotary), you need to change the dialling mode.

- Press Menu.
 - Press ▲ or ▼ to choose Initial Setup.
 Press OK.
- Press ▲ or ▼ to choose Tone/Pulse. Press OK.
- Press ▲ or ▼ to choose Pulse (or Tone). Press OK.
- 5 Press Stop/Exit.



Setting the phone line type

If you are connecting the machine to a line that features PBX or ISDN to send and receive faxes, it is also necessary to change the phone line type accordingly by completing the following steps.

- Press Menu.
- Press ▲ or ▼ to choose Initial Setup. Press OK.
- Fress ▲ or ▼ to choose Phone Line Set. Press OK.
- Press ▲ or ▼ to choose PBX, ISDN (or Normal).
 Press OK.
- 5 Press Stop/Exit.

PBX and TRANSFER

The machine is initially set to Normal, which lets the machine connect to a standard PSTN (Public Switched Telephone Network) line. However, many offices use a central telephone system or Private Automatic Branch Exchange (PBX). Your machine can be connected to most types of PABX. The machine's recall feature supports timed break recall only (TBR). TBR will work with most PABX systems allowing you to gain access to an outside line or send calls to another extension. The feature works when the **Tel/R** (MFC-440CN) or **R** (MFC-660CN) key is pressed.


🖉 Note

You can program a **Tel/R** (MFC-440CN) or **R** (MFC-660CN) key press as part of a number stored in a Speed-Dial location. When programming the Speed-Dial number, press **Tel/R** or **R** first (the LCD shows '!'), then enter the telephone number. If you do this, you do not need to press **Tel/R** or **R** each time before you dial using a Speed-Dial location.

13 Choosing a Receive Mode (For MFC-440CN)


There are four possible receive modes: Fax Only, Fax/Tel, Manual and External TAD.

4 Press \blacktriangle or \blacktriangledown to choose the mode. Press **OK**.

5 Press Stop/Exit.

15 Setting up the TAD (MFC-660CN only)

You must record an outgoing message in order to use the TAD mode.

Record the TAD outgoing message (TAD Message).



See Outgoing message (OGM) in Chapter 9 of the User's Guide.



Activate TAD mode.

Press (\frown_i) . The button will light when the mode is active.



If the TAD Mode is on, it overrides your Receive Mode setting. The built-in digital TAD answers voice calls. If the call is a fax, you can receive a fax automatically. For details, see Digital TAD in Chapter 9 of the User's Guide.
